THE GMMQ AND 5 ASSOCIATIONS SUBMIT A JOINT BRIEF TO THE TAXATION REVIEW PANEL

On October 23, the Alliance québécoise des techniciens de l'image et du son (AQTIS), the Association des réalisateurs et réalisatrices du Québec (ARRQ), the Guilde des musiciens et musiciennes du Québec (GMMQ), the Société des auteurs de radio, télévision et cinéma (SARTEC), the Société professionnelle des auteurs et compositeurs du Québec (SPACQ) and the Union des artistes (UDA) filed a joint brief written by Economists Pierre Fortin and Pierre Emmanuel Paradis to the Godbout taxation review panel calling on commissioners, and ultimately the government, not to cut in culture, an essential public good that may not survive another round of cuts.
